1. Born after January 1, 2022
2. July 1 – December 31, 2021
3. January 1 – June 30, 2021
4. July 1 – December 31, 2020 (Females only)
5. Born before June 30, 2020 (Females only)
6. Cow/calf pair.

- **No Bulls over 2 years of age at date of fair.**
- **Bulls over 6 months will be required to have nose ring at all times for duration of fair.**
- **No horns on any cattle.**
- **If any Board member or Livestock member observes any animal not being fed or watered, that student will be given a warning, 2nd offense could result in future eligibility to show.**
